



## **A Healthier Tomorrow Starts Today!**

The Healthy Families Program is a state and federally funded health coverage program for children with family incomes above the level eligible for no-cost Medi-Cal and below 250% of the Federal Income Guidelines (\$38,160 for a family of three).

### **Q: Where can I apply for the Healthy Families Program for my child(ren)?**

A: There are many community-based organizations, which can help you apply for the program. Some of these organizations include:

- Woman, Infants and Children Program (WIC)
- Maternal and Child Health Program (MCH)
- Child Health Disability Program (CHDP)
- California Children's Services (CCS)
- County Department of Social Services
- Schools, school districts and county offices
- Head Start, Healthy Start Program
- Child care organizations
- Parent Teacher Association (PTA)
- Religious organizations

### **Q: What are the eligibility requirements for the Program?**

A: The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Children up to their 19th birthday
- Children in families with incomes at or below 250% of the Federal Income Guidelines
- Children in families without employer-sponsored health insurance in the last three months
- Children living in California
- Children who are not eligible for no-cost Medi-Cal
- Children who meet citizenship/immigration requirements

### **Q: What are some of the benefits my child(ren) can receive?**

A: The Healthy Families benefit package is comprehensive. The benefit package includes:

- Coverage for medically necessary hospitalization
- Physician, medical and surgical services
- Inpatient and outpatient services
- Prescription drugs
- Well Child services
- Family planning
- Mental health
- Occupational, alcohol & drug treatment services, physical and speech therapies
- Lab and X-ray services
- Dental and vision services
